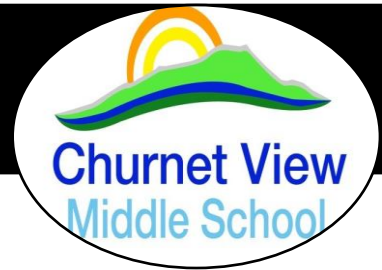


SAY HELLO TO YOUR
