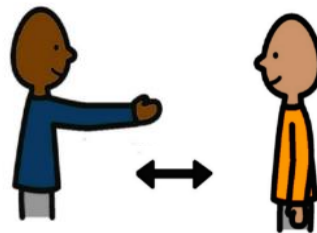


School Re-Opening to All Pupils

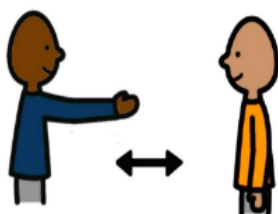

If you feel sad or worried you can talk to your parents or teachers and they will help you feel happy and calm.



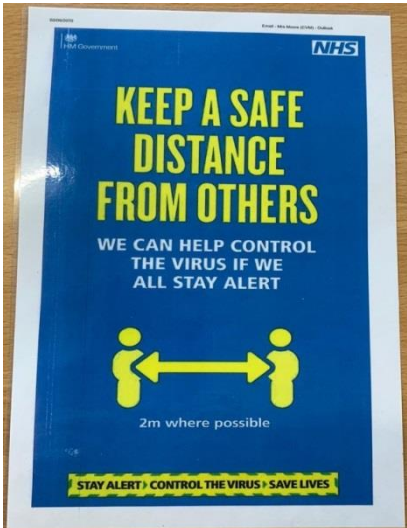
When you come in to school, you will be met by your teacher on the yard where you will line up in your author groups. You will sanitise your hands before you go into school.



You will see markers on the corridors which will remind you which way you need to go and to be socially distant from each other. You will need to wear a mask in the corridors and when you are moving around school.



You will see signs all around school which will be there to remind you about what to do to keep safe



Your classroom will look different to what you are used to but this is to keep you safe. All of the tables will be in the classrooms but the desks will be facing the front of the classroom where possible.

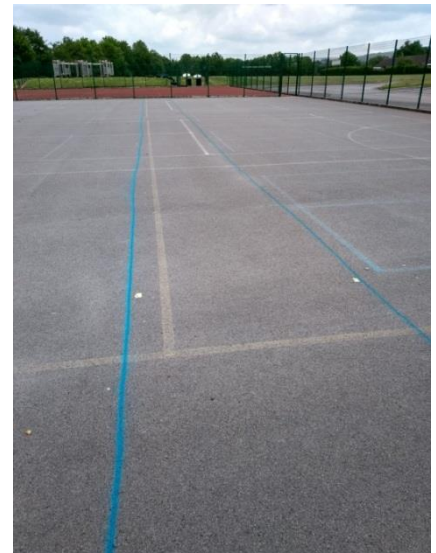
You will need to stay in your seat at all times during your lessons and listen to your teacher when they explain the new rules. This will happen when you spend longer with your form teacher on the first day back. They will go through everything with you and answer any questions you have.



There are painted markers on the floor to show you where to walk. The people show you the direction you need to go. You will come in through the side gate in the morning at the time allocated for your year group. You will then go on to the yard where your teachers will meet you and you will sanitise your hands.

Your year group will have its own area at break and lunchtime that you will need to stick to.

You will have lunch in the diner with pupils from your year group and then go outside to your area of the yard.





There will be an extra break time in the afternoon so that you can get some fresh air and sanitise your hands again.

Each year group will leave school at slightly different times so that you do not mix with other year groups.

When you get home, remember to wash your hands.
