These mock examinations will be held so that pupils are able to have a practice run through of the arrangements that will be in place for the SATs in May and so that their teachers are able to get a standardised idea of their working level under examination conditions. We understand that examinations can be stressful for pupils. However, please be reassured our aim is to make our pupils as familiar with the procedures as possible. This will then reduce any stress or anxieties they may be experiencing. Examinations will be held in classrooms with familiar members of staff.

This trial run will allow us to identify whether any changes or adjustments need making before the final examinations in May.

While we understand that absence is sometimes unavoidable, please do your best to make sure your child attends school and has the equipment they need during the week of the mock SATs. This will really help to prepare them and know what to expect for their examinations in May.

Over the next few months, we will be continuing to prepare your child as much as possible for the examinations. Should the Government release any further guidance regarding the tests we will let you know. We will also hold a further SATS information evening in the Spring Term.
